

Wrestling Answers to week 3, Rule 6

- 1) Rule 6, Section 7, Article 1 – 1 minute Sudden Victory, 2 30 second tiebreakers and final 30 second Ultimate Tiebreaker
- 2) Rule 6, Section 2, Article 2 – True
- 3) Rule 6, Section 2, Article 2 and Rule 6, Section 3, Article 1 – Referee flips disk, which ever color is facing up chooses odd or even choice. The 1st match selected is odd.
- 4) Rule 6, Section 3, Article 3 NOTE – Give opponent choice of position on the restart
- 5) Rule 3, Section 4, Article 2 – Stalemate, 2nd time Stalemate or Stalling, 3rd time Stalling
- 6) Rule 6, Section 4, Article 5 a,b,c – neutral position when no takedown is in progress, if wrestler is at disadvantage because its covering eyes, nose, mouth or causing choking, when there is no significant action taking place
- 7) Rule 6, Section 6, Article 1 – True – Errors requiring bad time to be re-wrestled must be corrected prior to the start of any subsequent period.
- 8) Rule 6, Section 7, Article 1c and 1-8, True
- 9) Rule 6, Section 7, Article 1-3, False, Top, Bottom or Defer
- 10) Rule 6, Section 7, Article 1-6, whoever scored 1st point in the regulation match unless there is an Unsportsmanlike Conduct penalty point, this supersedes 1st point scored. If neither, then flip disk
- 11) Rule 6, Section 7, Article 2 – True, Overtime is an extension of regular match
- 12) Most wrestlers have virtually no experience wrestling a blind wrestler. Notify the wrestler he/she must maintain contact at all times or will be penalized for unsportsmanlike conduct
- 13) Rule 6, Section 7, Article 1-6, flip of disk for top, bottom or defer
- 14) Kind of an unwritten rule, yes. Call stalemate 1st, maybe again before stalling
