- 1) When indication an infraction, the referee shall stop the match with the following 7 exceptions?
- 2) Review the entire penalty chart. What happens after 2-point stalling penalty?
- 3) Is it possible for a bleeding wrestler to win the match by default?
- 4) Is blood clean up counted as blood time? What is the signal to stop blood time?
- 5) What is the procedure if the wrestler exhibits signs of a concussion when an appropriate health-care professional(s) are present?
- 6) In the case manual – Rule 8, 8.1.2, what is the best way to assure the correct score?
- 7) When a match is stopped for injury but you as the referee determines that scoring would have been successful if wrestling had continued. What is the call?

What if it was bleeding?

- 8) How should penalty points be awarded.
- 9) In the case manual – Rule 8, 8.1.3 Situation B, what if the next penalty is the second stalling call?
- 10) In the case manual – Rule 8, 8.2.1 - do we always stop the match when a kid cries out, scream rule?
- 11) Case manual - can a wrestler take injury time after recovery time?
- 12) Case manual 8.2.7 Situation A, what is used first, injury, recovery or blood time?
- 13) If dual meet ends in a tie score, what are 1st and 2nd criteria used to determine the winner? What is the New Criteria?
- 14) How many team points is a double forfeit?
